PART B – ARCADE LASER TAG HIRE INSTRUCTIONS (Customer Copy)

1. Do not turn the tagger off while in start up phase. Please wait for start up noise to finish before turning off the tagger.
2. Game mode is 5 lives or 12 minutes, whichever ends first. Gun colours are not important. This is a free for all format.
3. Scopes are turned on and off by twisting the big dial on top. Do not twist the small dials. Handle taggers carefully to avoid knocking the scope.
4. Aim for the bubbles on the tagger. Play fair and do not cover the bubbles with your hand.
5. Allow one metre between players to help avoid collisions and potential harm.

Operation

Trigger allows the player to shoot. Taggers are set to fully automatic.

Red button reloads and takes two seconds.

Black button shows player stats during the game.

Key switch turns the tagger on and off.

Do not press any buttons while turning the tagger on or off. This may enter configuration or factory reset mode.

Do not turn the tagger off during start up.

Important Notes

Keep taggers dry at all times.

Water damage is not covered.

Play safely and respect other players and equipment.
